**CSS URL**  default: /jw/css/new.css

**Custom CSS**

<b>CSS URL</b>	Custom CSS file to replace the default look and feel of the web console. (Default CSS file resides at /jw/css/v3.css)
<b>Custom CSS</b>	Inline custom CSS to be appended into the web console in addition to the default/CSS URL.
<b>System Locale</b>	Default system wide locale.
<b>Using Locale Date Format</b>	Determines if user/system's locale date format is to be used.
<b>Enable User Locale Selection</b>	Enables locale selection to users through User Profile.
<b>User Locale Options (Language code, separated by comma ',')</b>	Selection of locales available to users. (" <b>Enable User Locale Selection</b> " must be active first.)
<b>Display From Right to Left</b>	Enable RTL support.

<b>Workflow Designer Base URL</b>	Workflow Designer Base URL. Defaulted to current Joget server path.
<b>Delete Process On Completion</b>	Delete process instance data on when process instance comes to an end.
