

Published Processes

Published Processes is a section where users can start processes of published applications without having to go through the Userview.

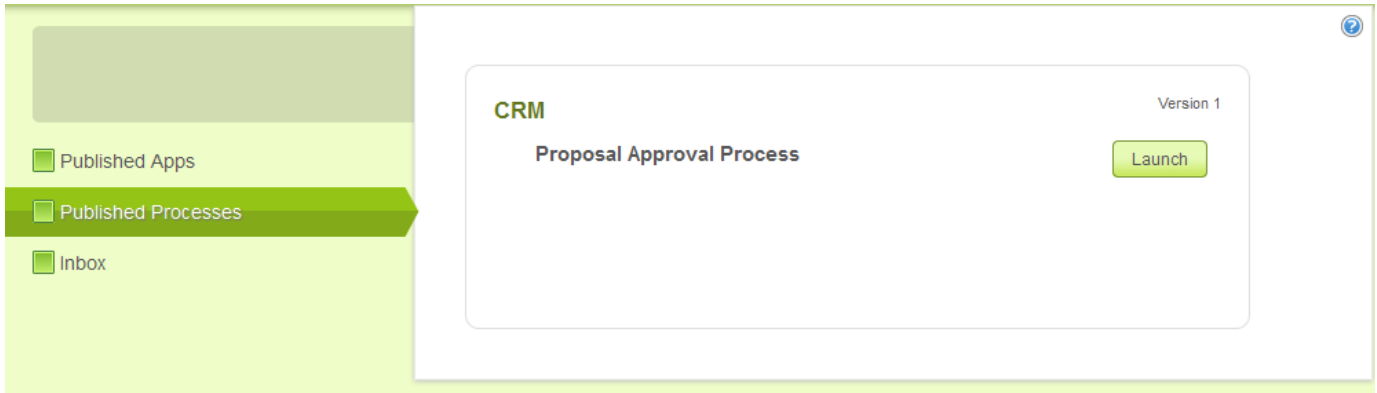


Figure 1: Published Processes

You can control who starts a process through the **Process Start White List** setting.
