

# Hyperlink

**Hyperlink Action** allows you to add a hyperlink to your records.

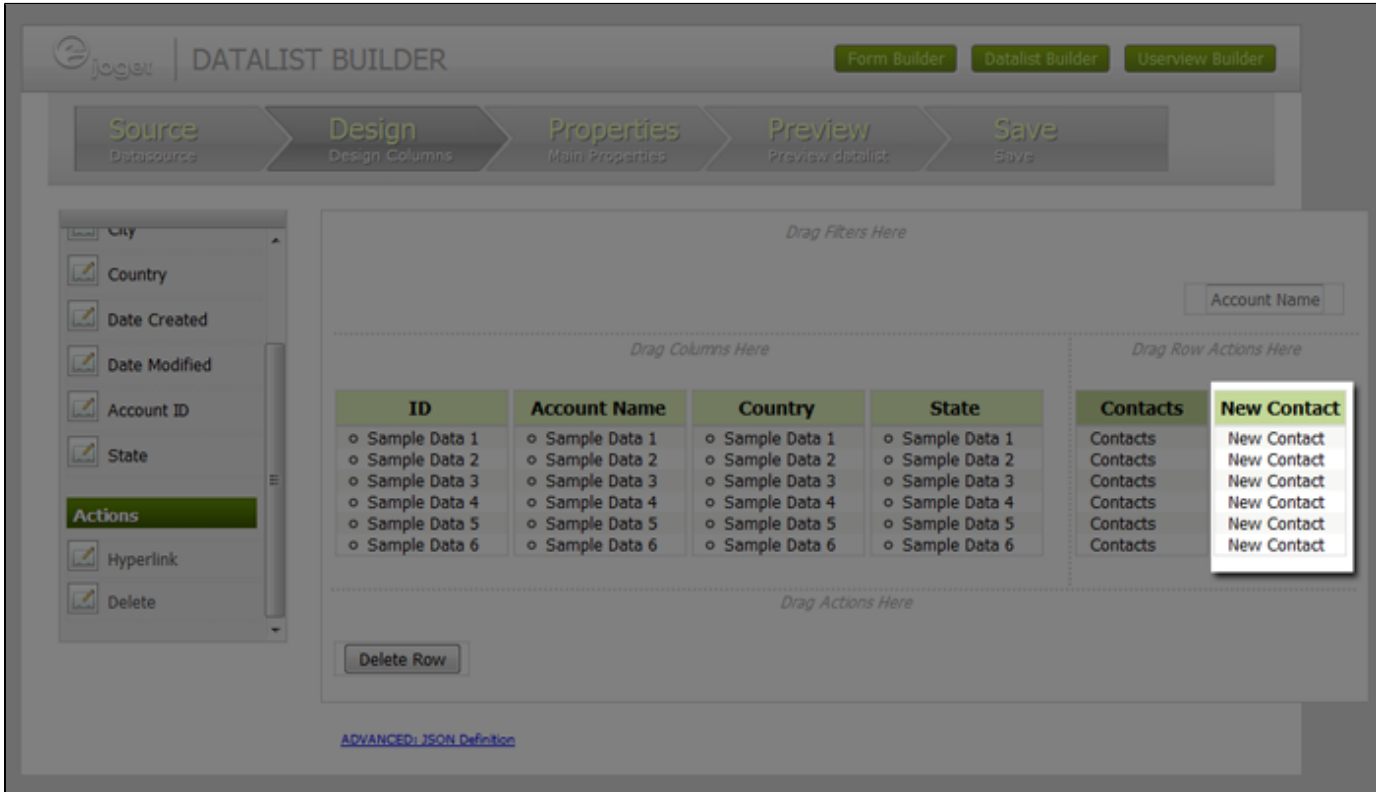


Figure 1: Hyperlink Action in Datalist Builder

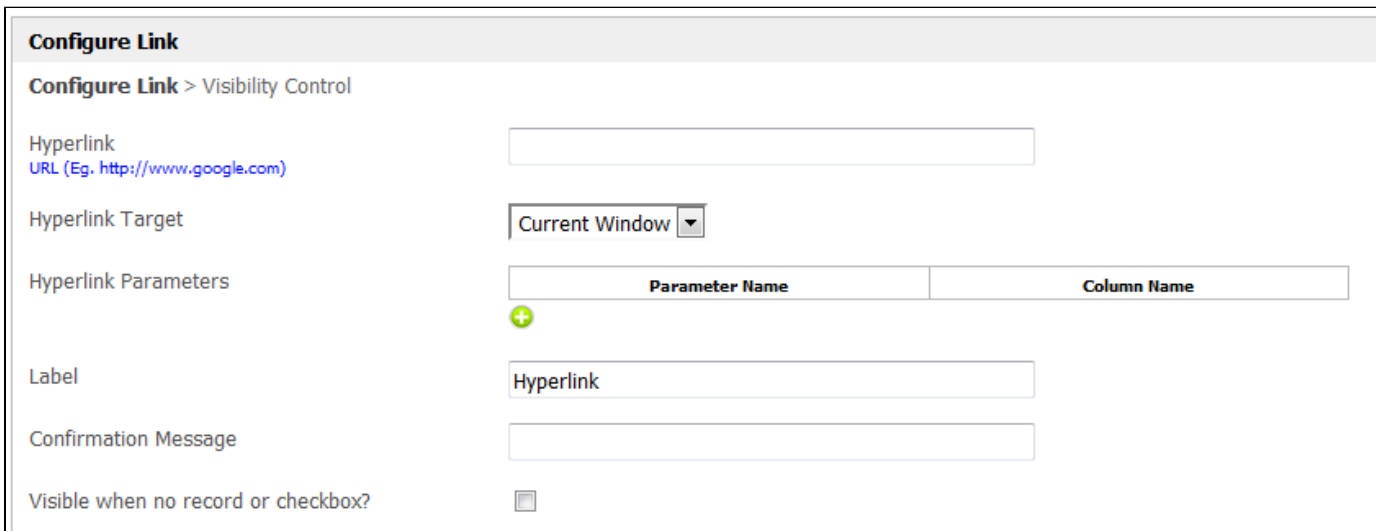


Figure 2: Hyperlink Action Properties - Configure Link

| <b>Hyperlink</b>        | <p>URL of the link, with the following possible values:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Absolute URL - points to another website (like href="http://www.example.com/default.htm")</li> <li>Relative URL - points to a file within a website (like href="default.htm")</li> <li>Anchor URL - points to an anchor within a page (like href="#top")</li> </ul> |
| <b>Hyperlink Target</b> | The way a link is opened   |

| <b>Label</b>                               | Name of the action  |

| <b>Visible when no record or checkbox?</b> | Determines whether this action should be shown when there's no record returned. Applicable only when the action is used as a 'List Action'. |
