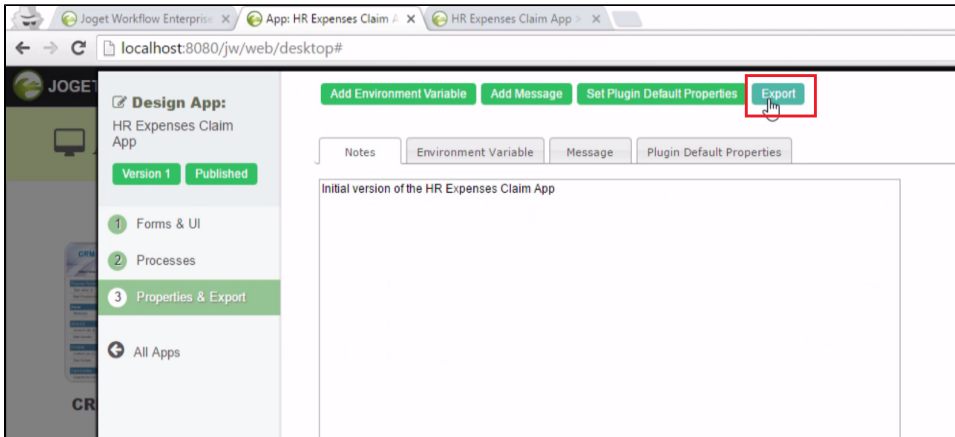

This article is only applicable to users who want to import a copy-protected Joget Workflow app into their Joget Workflow server. The article will show you how you can activate the copy-protected app.

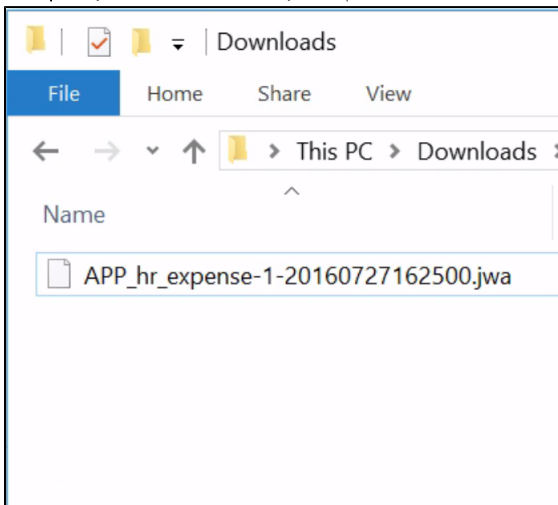
## Instructions

### 1. Exporting the App

- From your Joget Workflow's App Center, go to your intended App's design.



- Click on **Properties & Export**.
- Click **Export**. A .jwa file will be downloaded to your computer.



### 2. Request for App Protection

- Open your web browser, navigate to our [License Activation site here](#).

- Click on **Request for App Protection**. Fill up all the fields and submit.
