

# Signature

## Definition

Signature is a special element with canvas to collect user's input by scribbling/sketching on it.

Figure 3: Signature properties

Name	Description
ID	Element ID (By declaring as "signature", a corresponding database table column "c_signature" will be created)
Label	Element Label to be displayed to end user.
Encryption	Determines if the value should be encrypted upon saving into the database.

Name	Description
Validator	Attach a Validator plugin to validate the input value. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>i</b> When will validation takes place?</p> <p>Validation will takes place whenever form is submitted except when it is submitted as "Save as Draft".</p> </div>
Width	Width of the element in character. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Example</b></p> <p>300px</p> </div>
Height	Height of the element in character. <div style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Example</b></p> <p>300px</p> </div>
Readonly	Determines if the element is editable.
