

Bean Shell Tool

Bean Shell Tool enables you to execute a [bean shell script](#) within your process. A bean shell script can be used to interact with external systems, read and write workflow variables, and modify form data. When configuring the tool, enter your bean shell script in the popup plugin configuration window.
