

Datasource & Profile

Definition

Datasource & Profile Settings management makes it easy for you to switch between different profiles that hold individual database settings. Only one active profile is allowed at any time.

Joget Workflow is backed with [Hibernate](#) which enables it to connect to major RDBMS (Relational Database Management System). Out of the box, the Joget installer comes embedded with MySQL DBMS but it may be connected to other RDBMS easily such as **Microsoft SQL Server, Oracle**, and so on.
