## Definition

**Multirow Form Binder** is specifically designed to cater to multi-row-enabled form element to store multi-row data in database table structured form.



### Scope of use

Multirow Form Binder is only applicable when used in Form Element that calls for multi-row data treatment such as the [Form Grid](#).

Edit Form Grid > UI > **Validation & Data Binder** > Load Binder (Multirow Form Binder) > Store Binder (Multirow Form Binder)
