

Show and Hide Form Sections

You can make a section of a form visible or hidden depending on the value of other form fields.

In the example below, we want to show only the **Rejection** section when **Status** is set to **Rejected**.

Figure 1: Show/Hide Section Depending on Field Value

Configuration of visibility is done in the target section. Remember to retrieve the information needed from the **Select Box** properties first.

Figure 2: Properties of Select Box "Status"

In **Select Box** properties, take note of **ID** and **Options**. Next, go to the target section's properties, click on the **Visibility** tab and configure according to desired settings.

An example is shown below.
