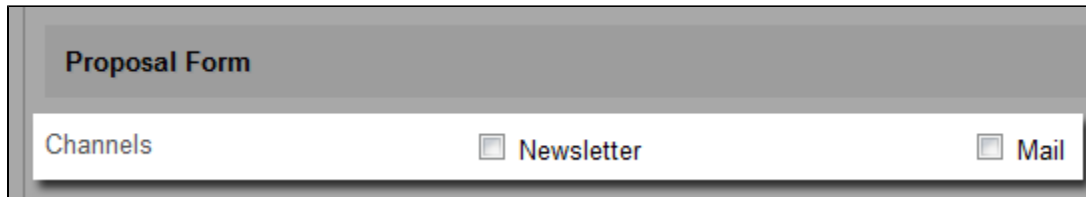


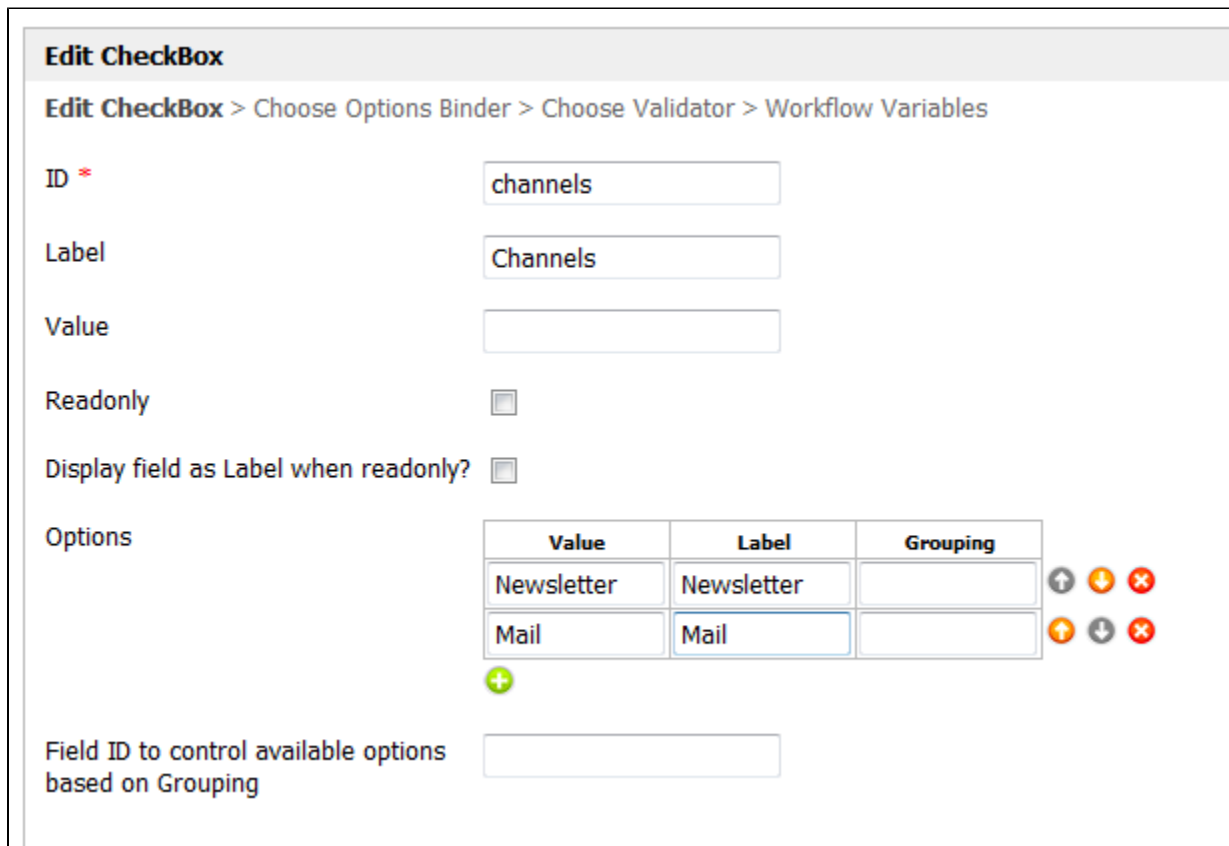
CheckBox

CheckBox enables one to make multiple selections. Its configuration is very similar to that of [SelectBox](#).
