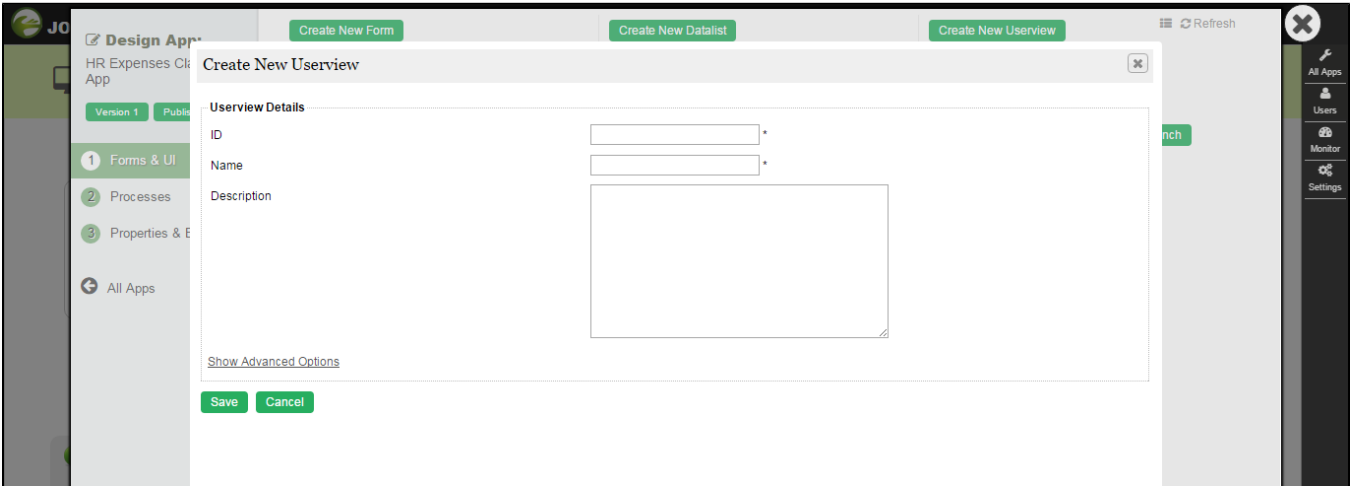


Figure 1: Create New Userview

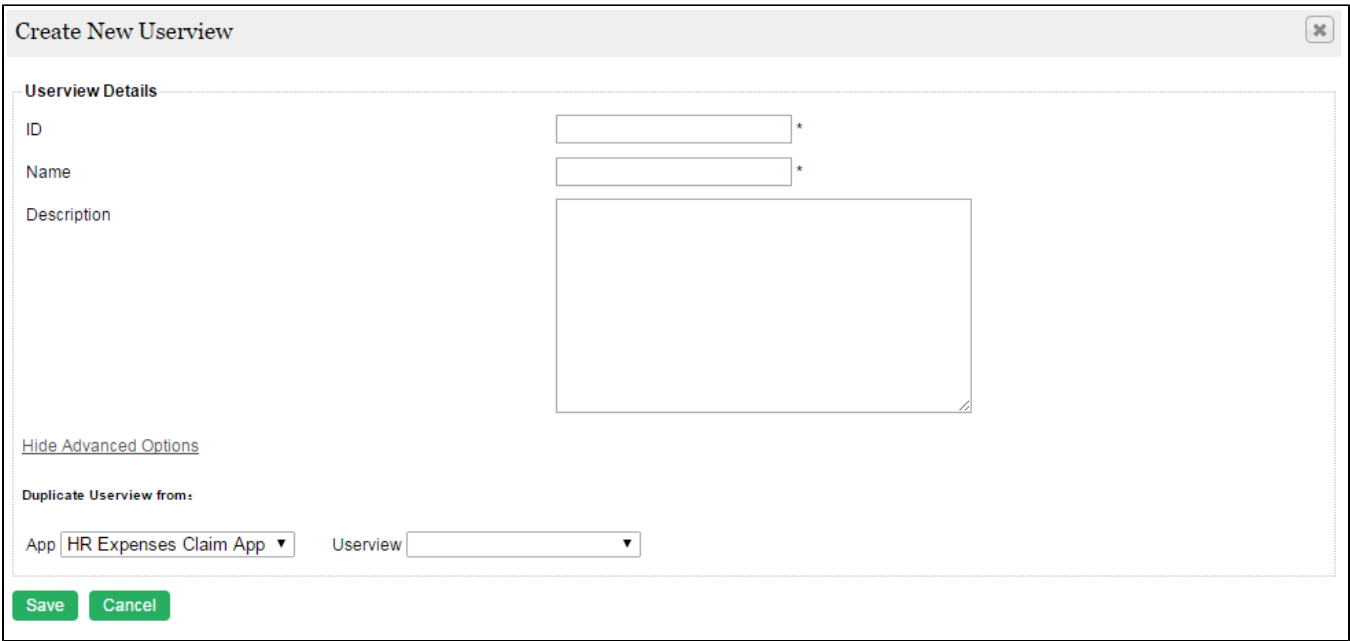


Figure 2: Create New Userview - Advanced Options
