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Introduction

Form Column is the placeholder to hold Form Elements. Each section has one column in it by default. At the section level, you may add more columns to it.

Get Started

The easiest way to see how the Form Column works is to use the existing built-in App Expenses Claims. Here are the steps:

1. Start the **Joget Server** and open the **App Center**.
2. Log in as **admin** and click on the pencil icon on the **Expenses Claim** to open the **App Composer** (see Figure 1).

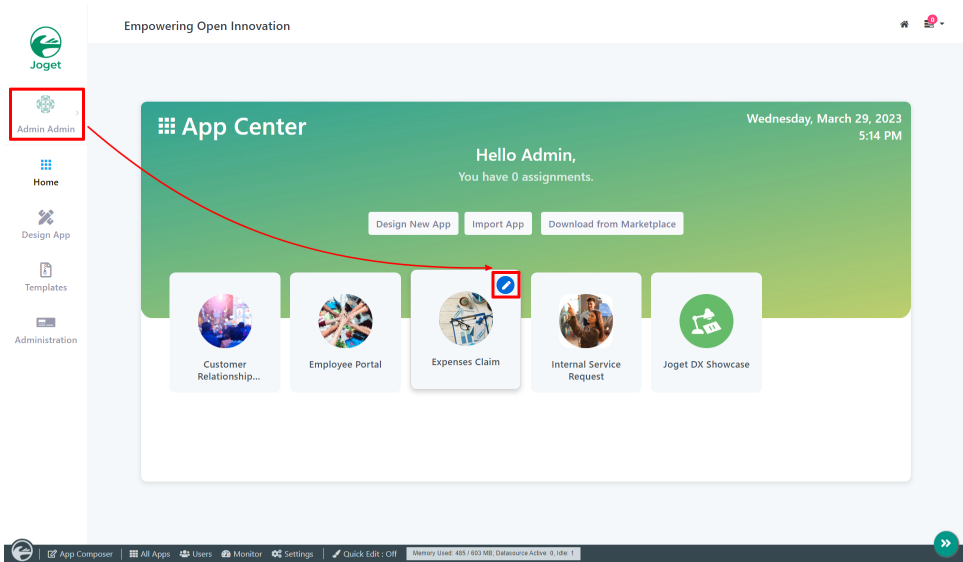

3. Click on **Expense Claim New** and you will be directed to the **Form Builder**.
4. **Click** on any field then click on the select parent button (see Figure 2). Column will be selected and the Configure Column properties will open (see Figure 3).

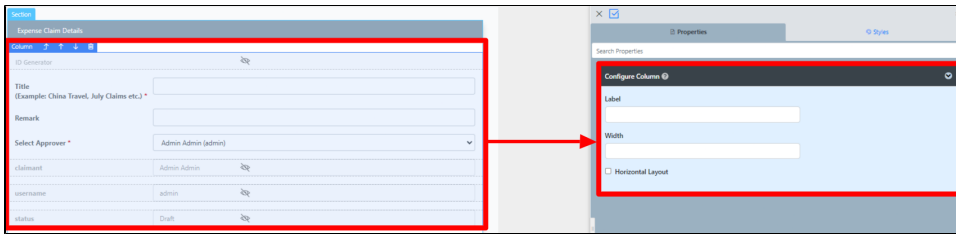

5. To add new columns, click on the section for the options to appear then click on **Add Column** button (see Figure 4)

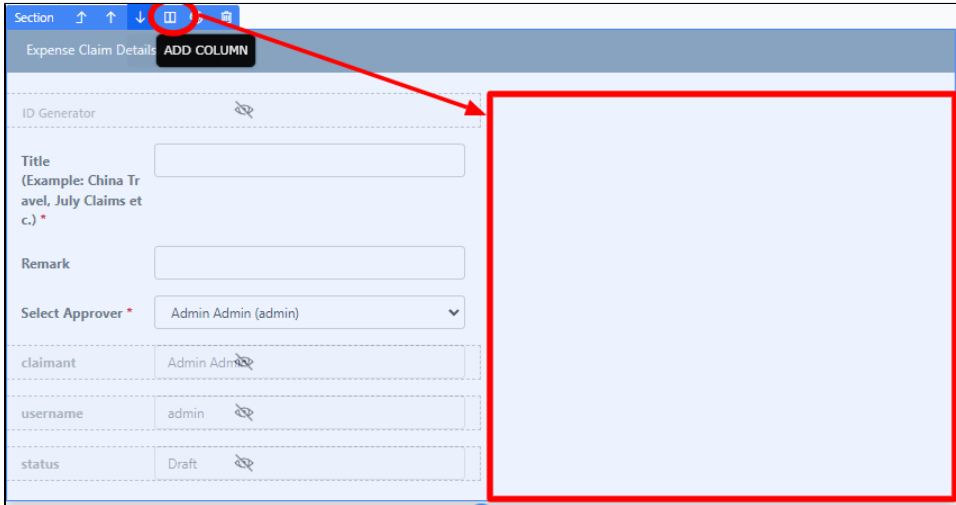

6. To edit specific column, click anywhere within that specific column (see Figure 5)

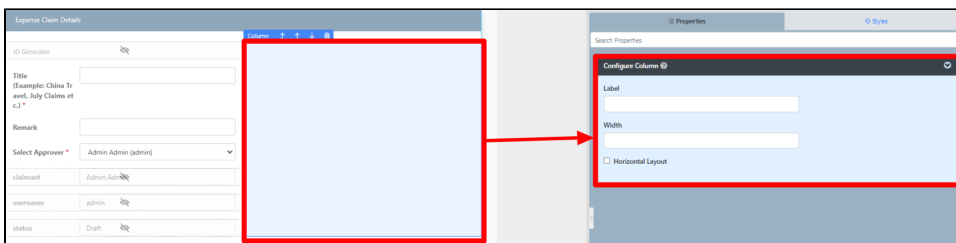
