## Introduction

**Options Formatter** allows you to transform values on the list column into their corresponding option values and labels.

## Options Formatter Properties




Figure 1: Options Formatter Properties

Name	Description
Options	Options to be populated for the column value to be matched against.  Column value will be matched against <b>'value'</b> and <b>'label'</b> to be displayed to the end user.
