This is a new feature in **Joget DX 8**.

Introduction

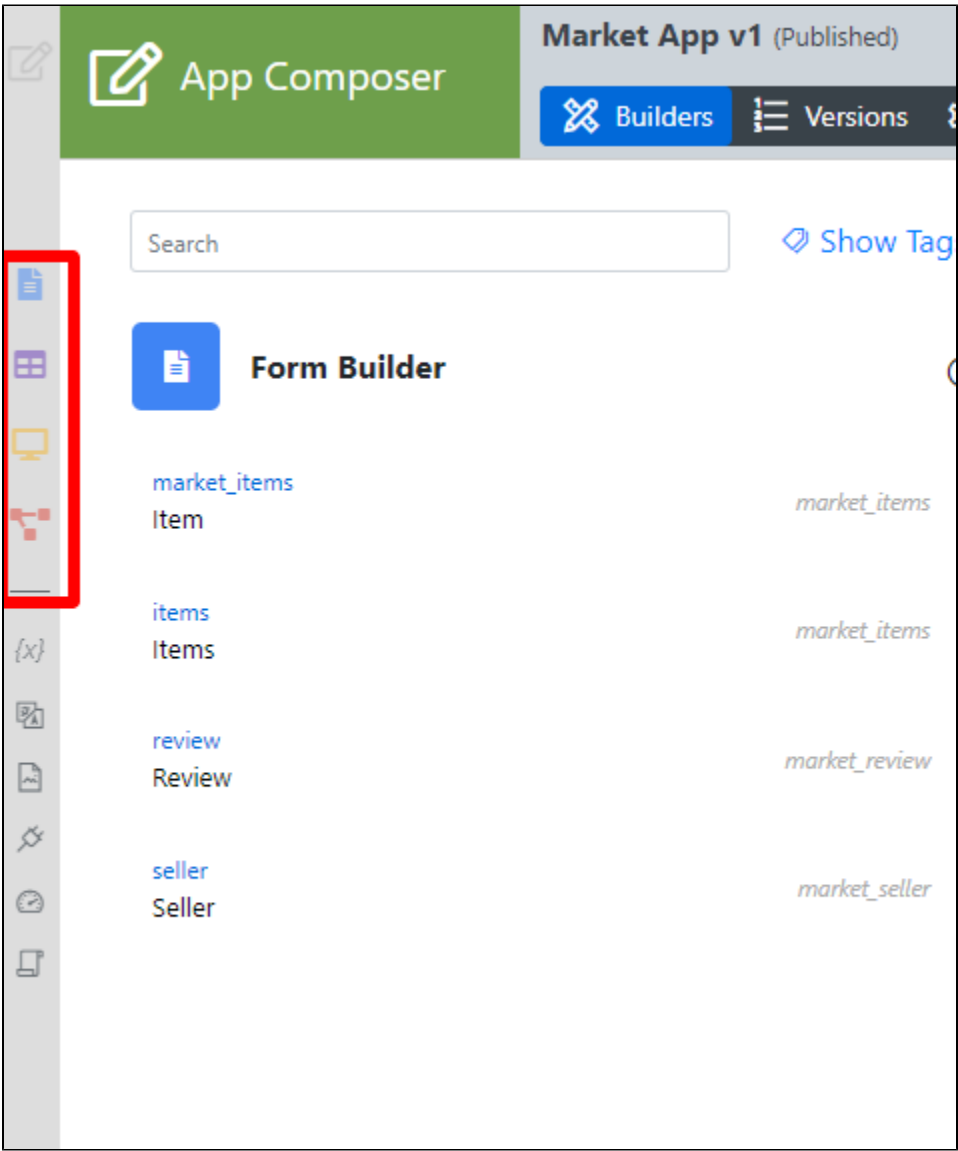


Figure 1: Minimized Quick Navigator

The **Quick Navigator**, or **Quick Navigation Bar**, is a new feature introduced in Joget DX 8 with the new **App Composer**. The **Quick Navigator** allows one to fast switch between the app components just by clicking on them. Under normal circumstances, the **Quick Navigator** will always be minimized as shown in Figure 1.

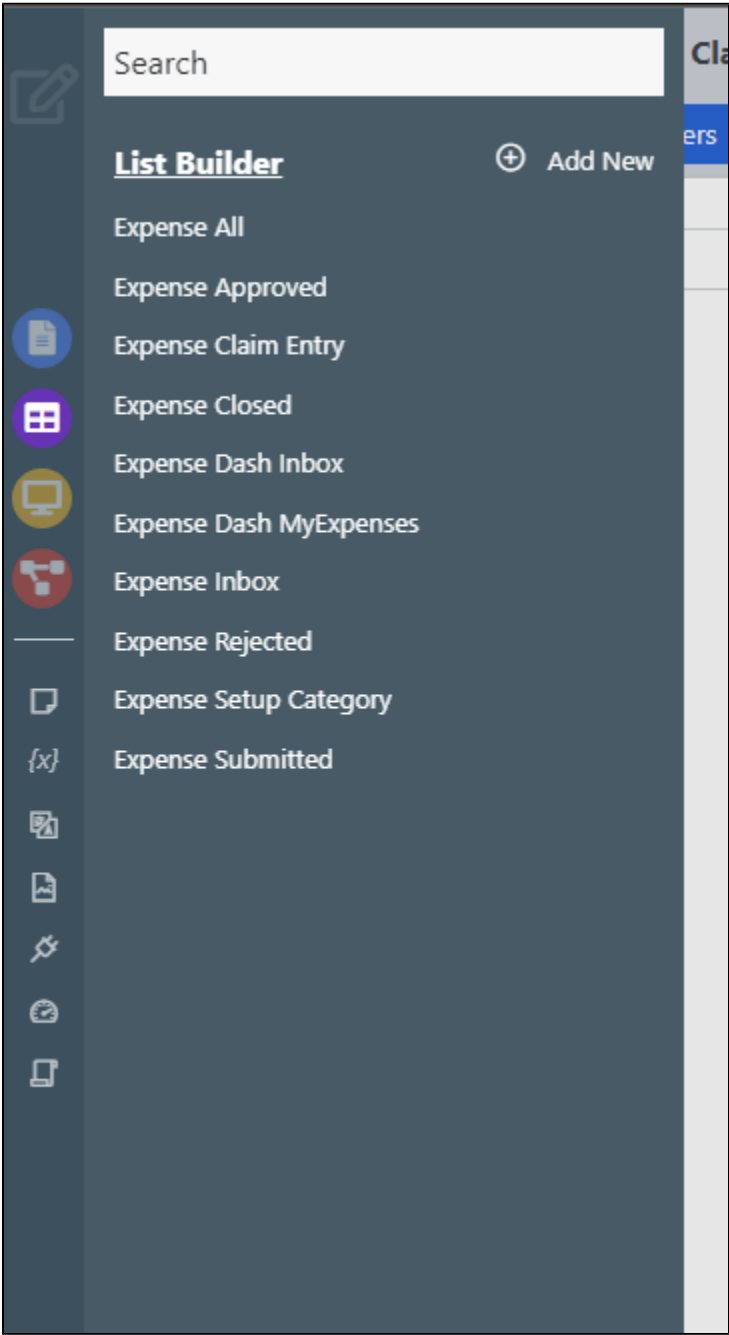


Figure 3: Quick Navigator in Action - List Builder

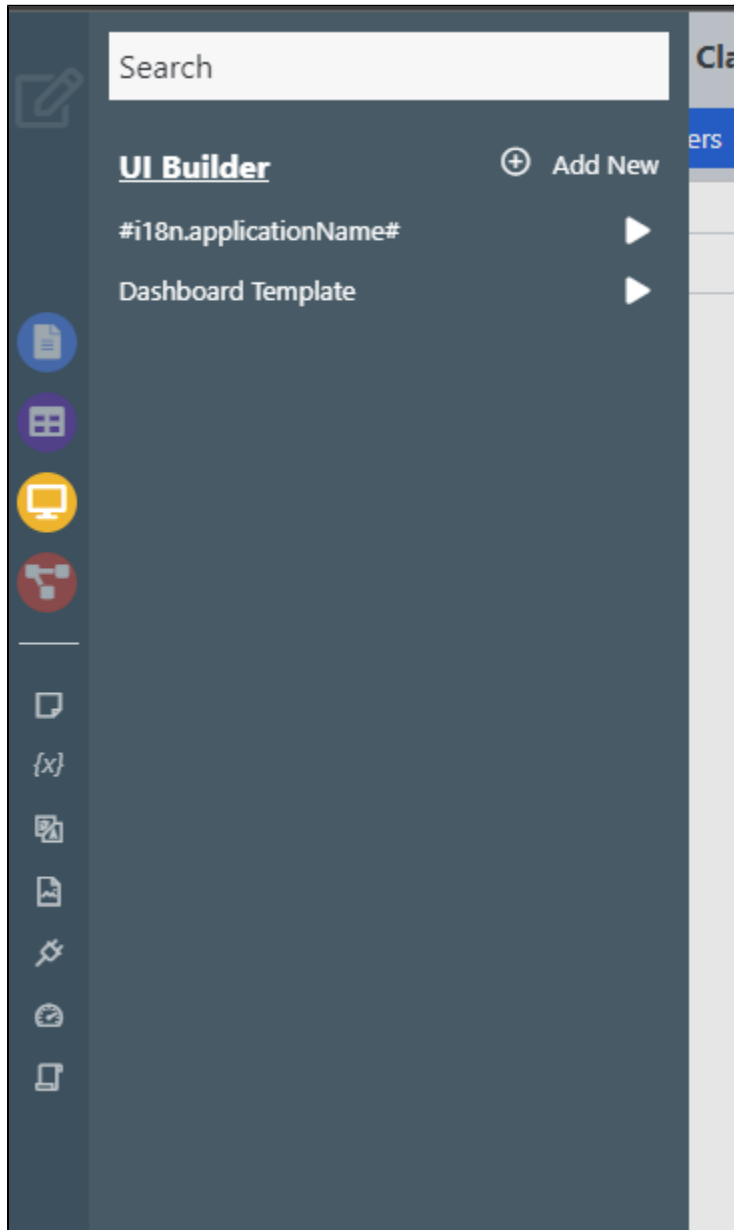


Figure 4: Quick Navigator in Action - UI Builder

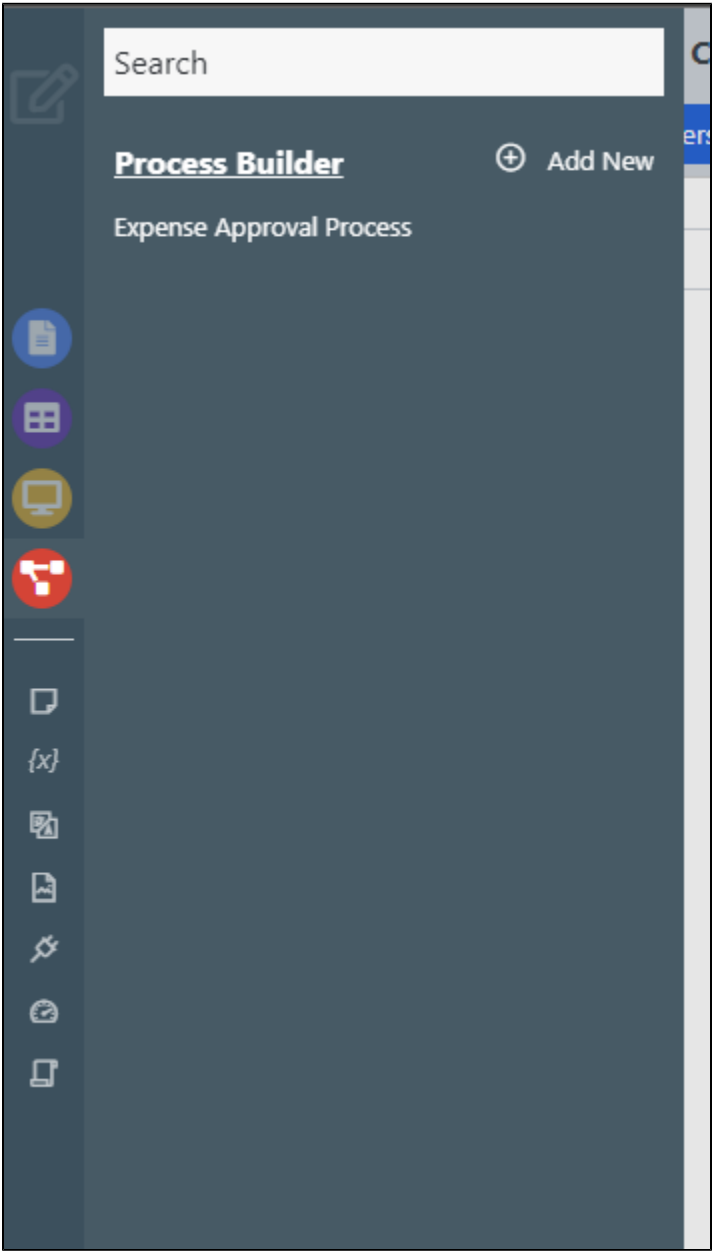


Figure 5: Quick Navigator in Action - Process Builder

When an app component is clicked, the **Quick Navigator** will expand and allow one to switch to other app components, or choose the elements to be edited within that app component as shown in Figure 2, Figure 3, Figure 4 and Figure 5.
