

Add jQuery Tooltip to form


1. Use the following code to incorporate jQuery Tooltip into the form. Add a Custom HTML and add in the following code. Amend accordingly.

<script type="text/javascript">
$(function() {

//customize your hints here by specifying form element ID on the left and message on the right
messages = { 'title' : 'Key in a suitable title',
              'remark' : 'Extra note goes here'};

//do not modify anything below here.
$( document ).tooltip({
  items: "input",
  content: function() {
    var element = $( this );
    if( messages[$(element).attr("name")] ){
      return messages[$(element).attr("name")];
    }else{
      return false;
    }
  }
});
});
</script>
```

2. The next time when someone hover over the field, the hint will show up.
