
## General Settings - Server Locale and Time Zone



You can define the **system locale** (timezone and language) that Joget Workflow should use rather than using the server's default.

It is also possible to define the date format rather than using the default one.

By changing the locale, this would affect how date/time and language is presented system-wide.




Figure 1: Inbox using en\_US locale - Showing the interface language in English and date format in en\_US locale.
