Introduction

The **Process Mapper** allows one to alternatively map participants, activities, tools, and routes visually in a process design view

 Please take note that the **Decision Tool Plugin** will take **precedence** over existing conditional setup in the **Process Builder**

Get Started

We will be using the existing built-in App Expenses Claims as an example. Here are the steps to access to the Process Mapper:

1. Start **Joget Server** and open the **App Center**.
2. Log in as **admin** and click on the pencil icon on the **Expenses Claim** to open the Design App. (see Figure 1)

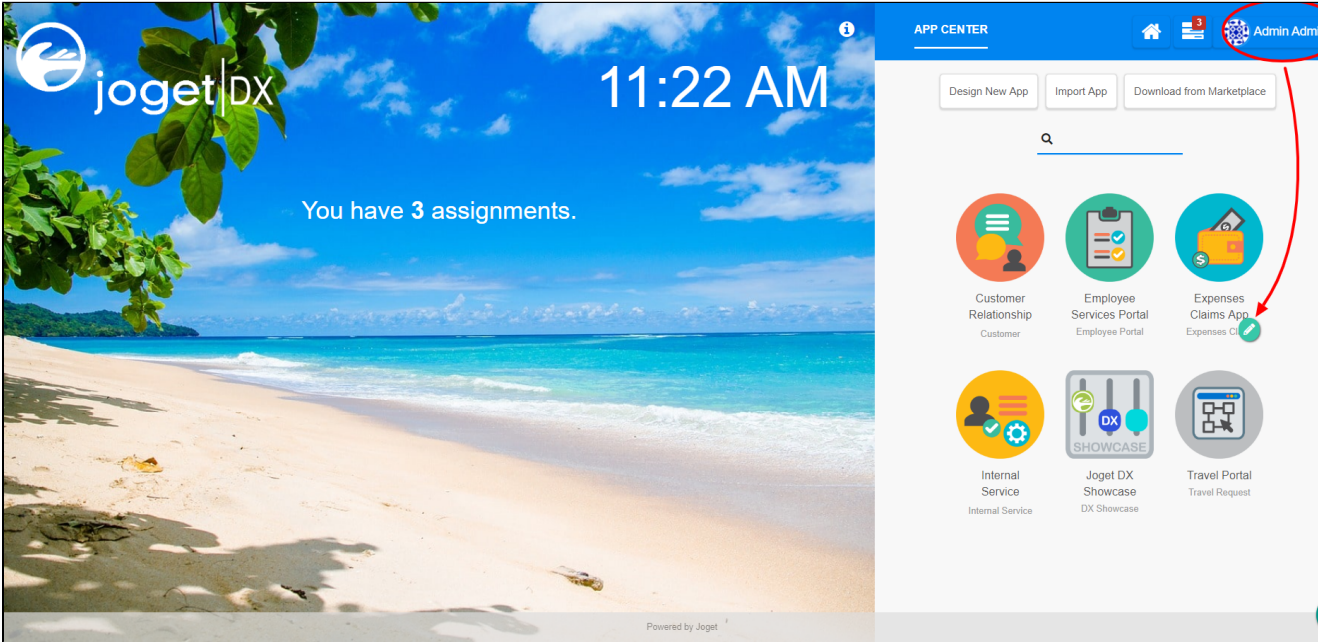

3. In the **Design App**, click on **Processes** and click on **Map Routes to Plugins**.
4. Click on **Configure Mapping** button (see Figure 2)

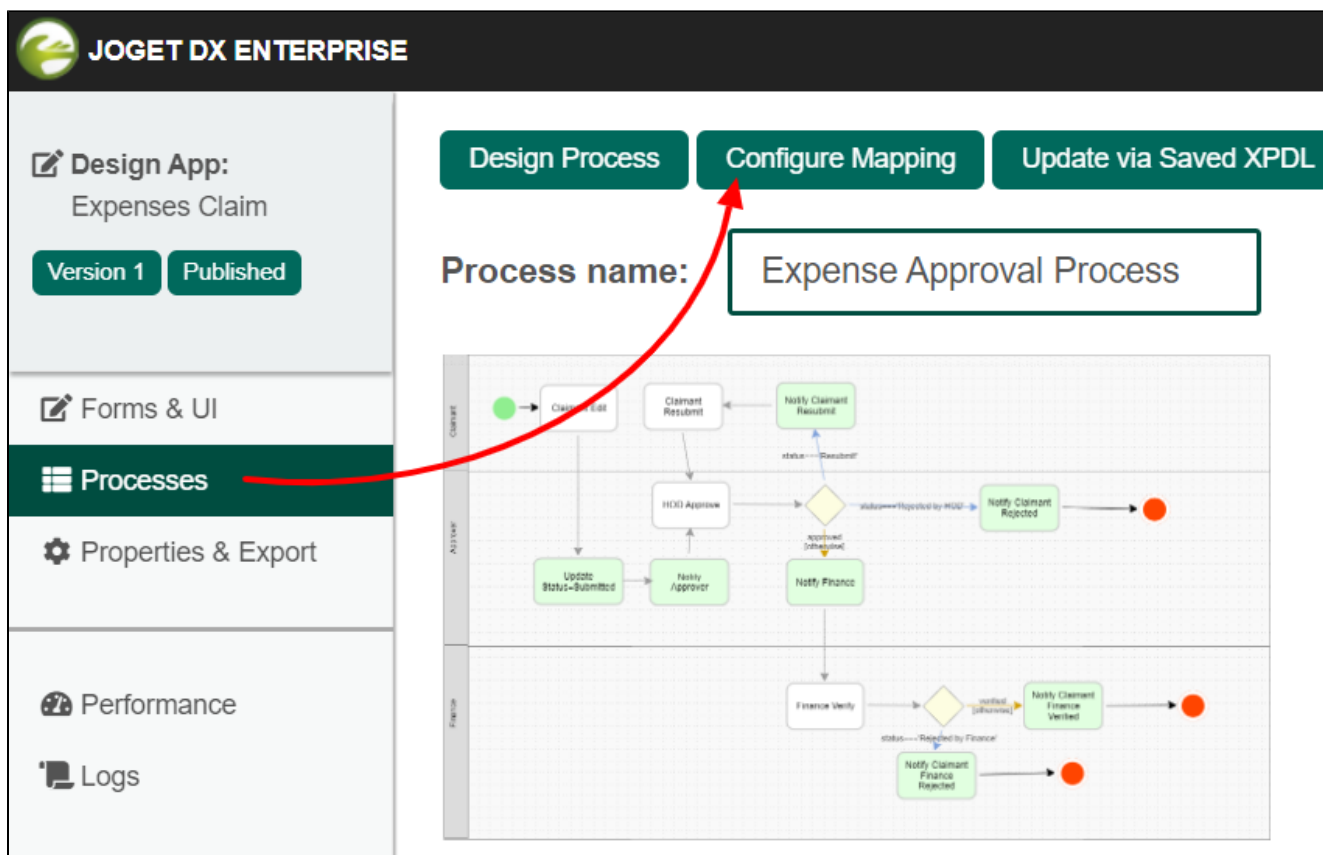
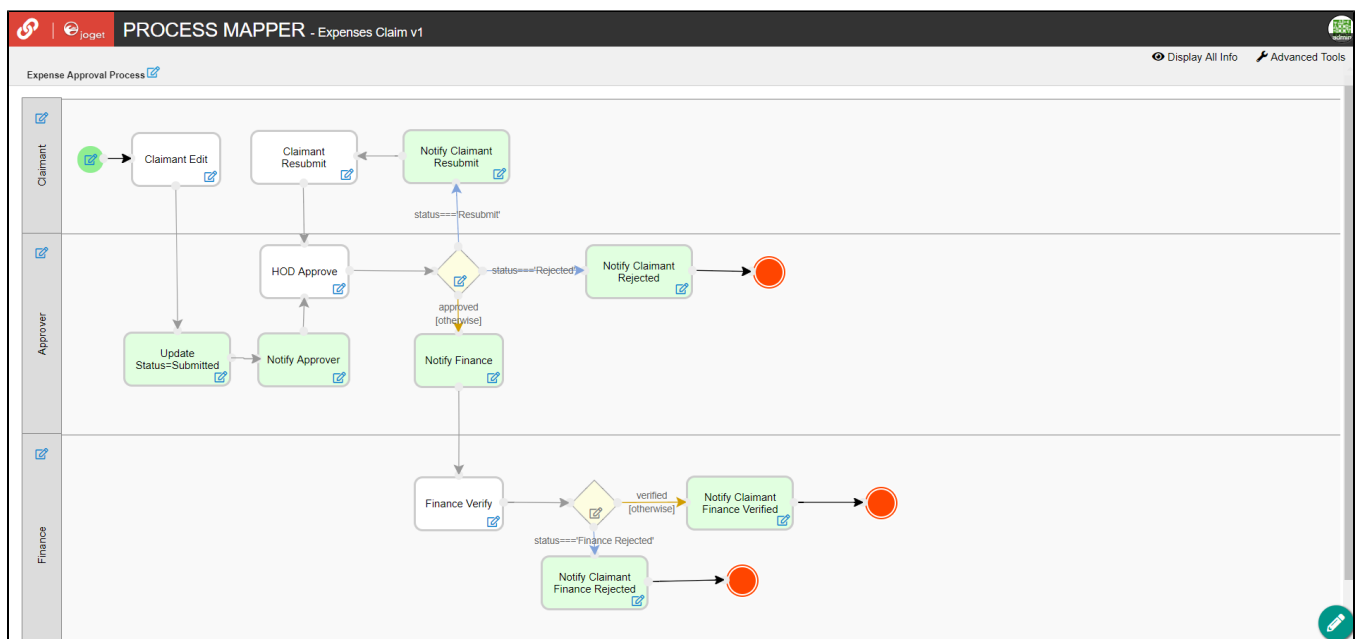

Process Mapper Properties



Name	Description
<Process Name>	Clicking on the Process Name will display the Process Start White List in the Map Participants to Users

<Participant Name>	Clicking on the Participant Name will display the Mapping Options in the Map Participants to Users
Start	Clicking on the Start node will display the Run Process in the Map Activities to Forms
Activity	Clicking on any of the Activity nodes will display the Mapping Options in the Map Activities to Forms
Tool	Clicking on any of the Tool nodes will display the Plugin Options in the Map Tools to Plugins
Route	Clicking on any of the Route nodes will display the Plugin Options in the Map Routes to Plugins
Display All Info	<p>When hovering the mouse over the Display All Info, a list of Info types will be available as shown below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants - Displays Participant Type and Value of each Participants and the Process Name (as the Process White List) • Activity - Displays the Form Name mapped to each activity nodes (and the Start node) • Tool - Displays the Plugin Name and Plugin Version of each Tool node. • Route - Displays the Plugin Name and Plugin Version of each Route node. • Hide All - Hides all info
Advanced Tools	Displays i18n Internationalization tab in Builder Advanced Tools

Deleting Existing Mapped Plugins on the Process Mapper

To delete existing mapped plugins, hover the mouse to a node and click on the red button.
