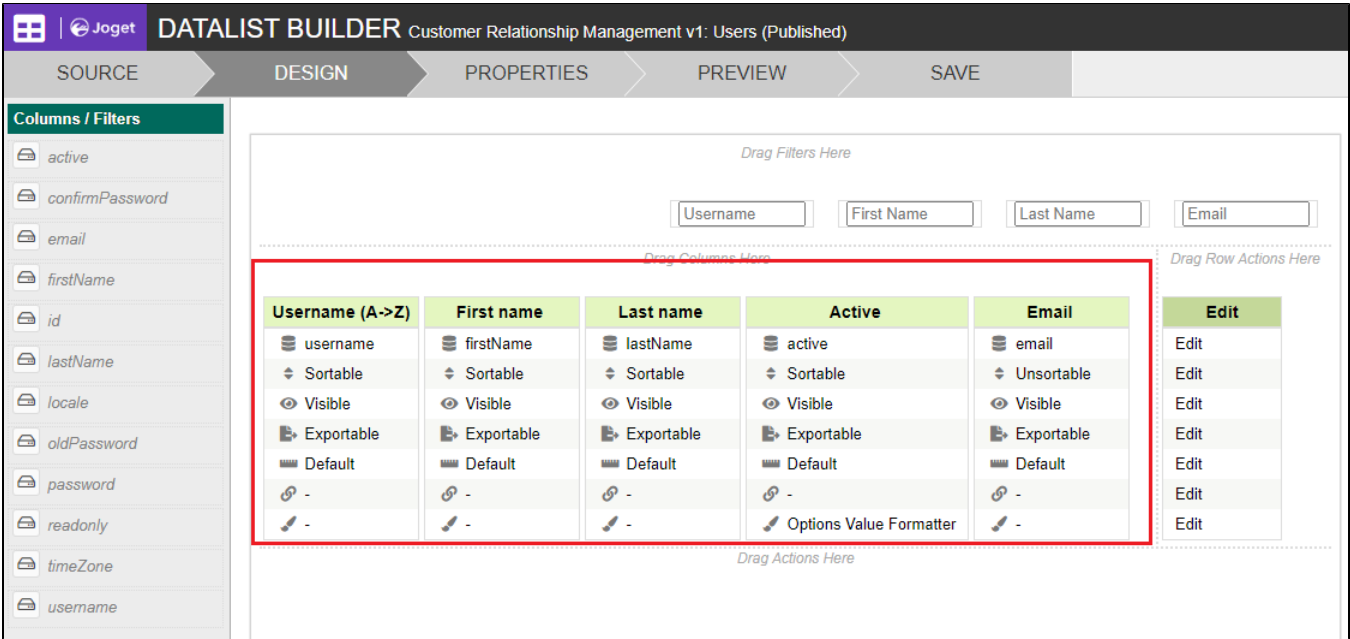


Figure 1: Screenshot highlighting columns added in Datalist Builder
