General - Name	Description
Mobile Offline Cache Enabled	When enabled, mobile offline caching capability will be used during offline when possible and when realtime server respond is not required. Network status will be indicated as depicted in Figure 6 . (e.g. User will be able to reopen links/pages in offline mode (as they have been cached) that have been opened before when the user was online)
Mobile Login Required First	Determine whether a user must first login into Joget or not before viewing the Userview.

Mobile View Background Color	Background Color (e.g. #FCFDED)

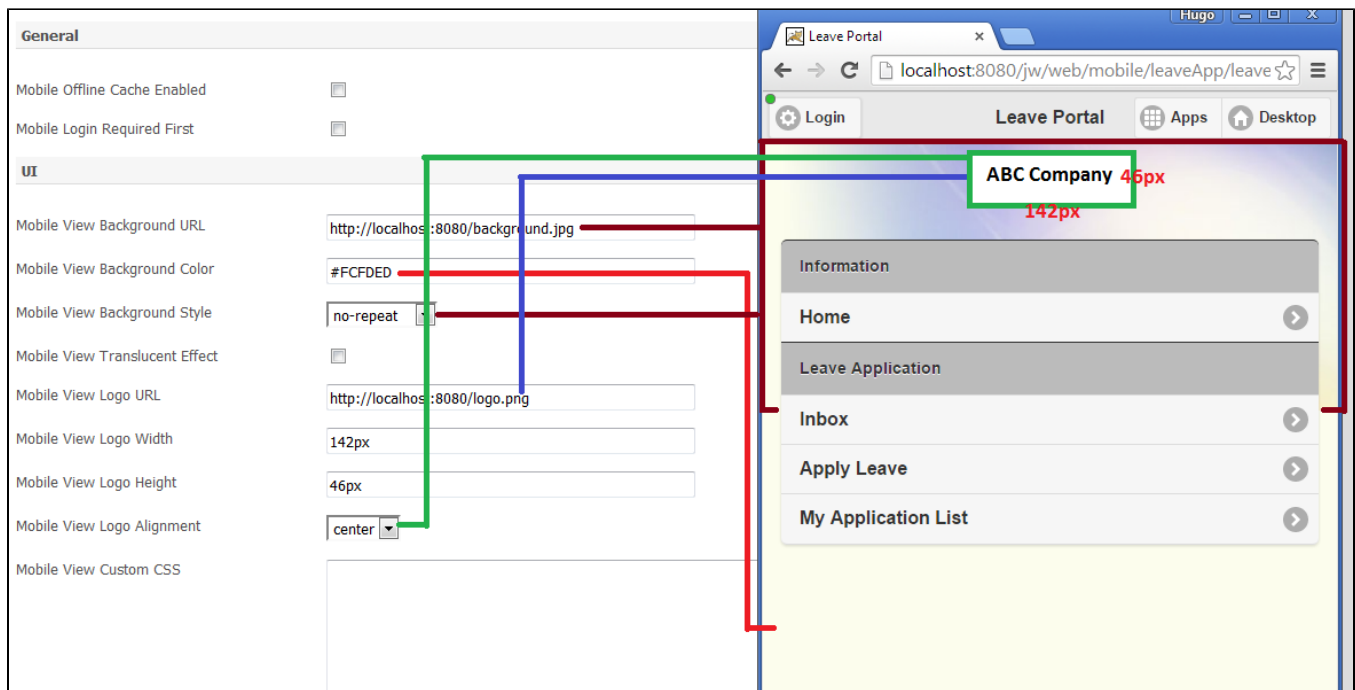


Figure 5: Sample Mobile View Configurations and its preview

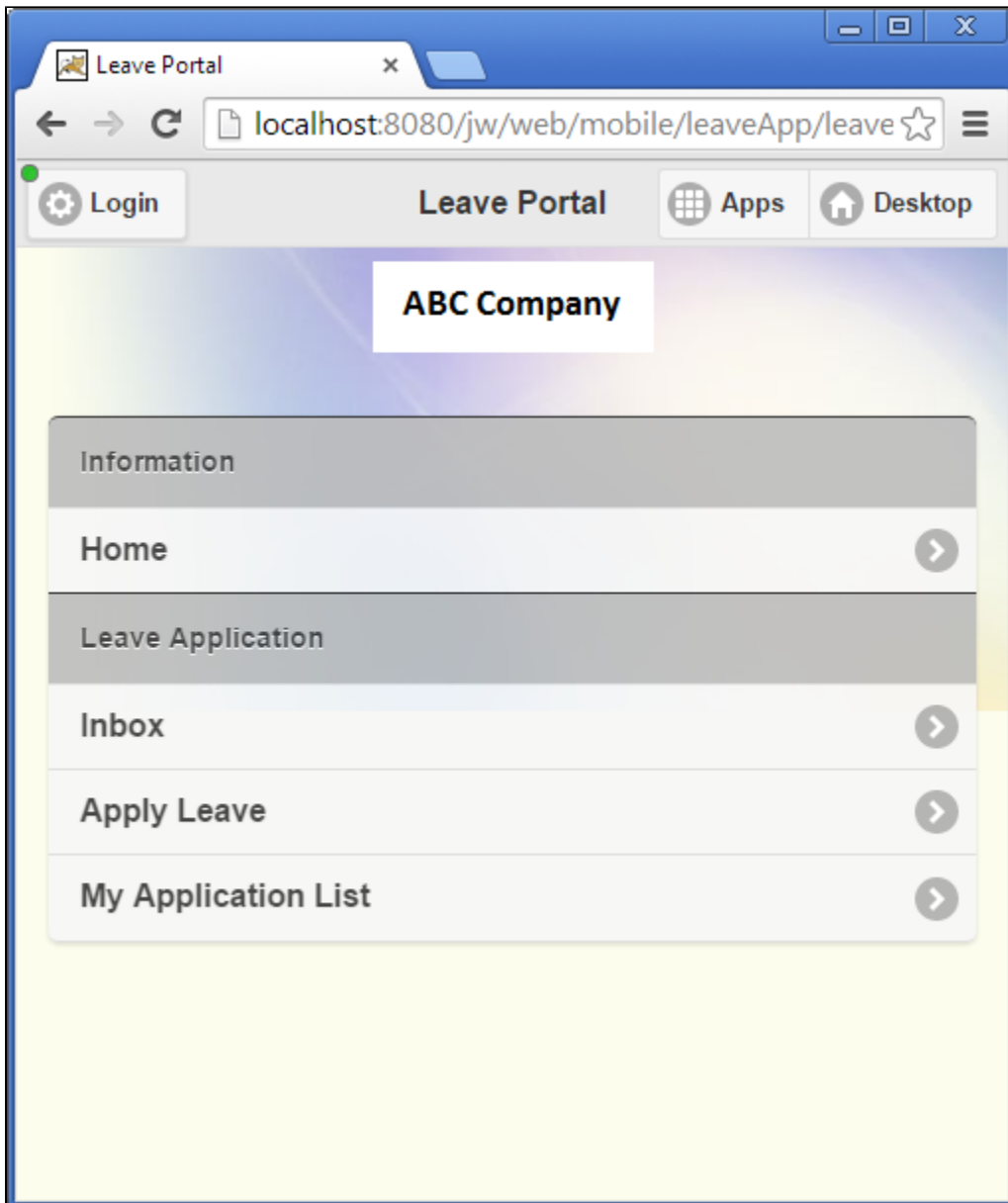


Figure 6: Sample Mobile View with Translucent effect

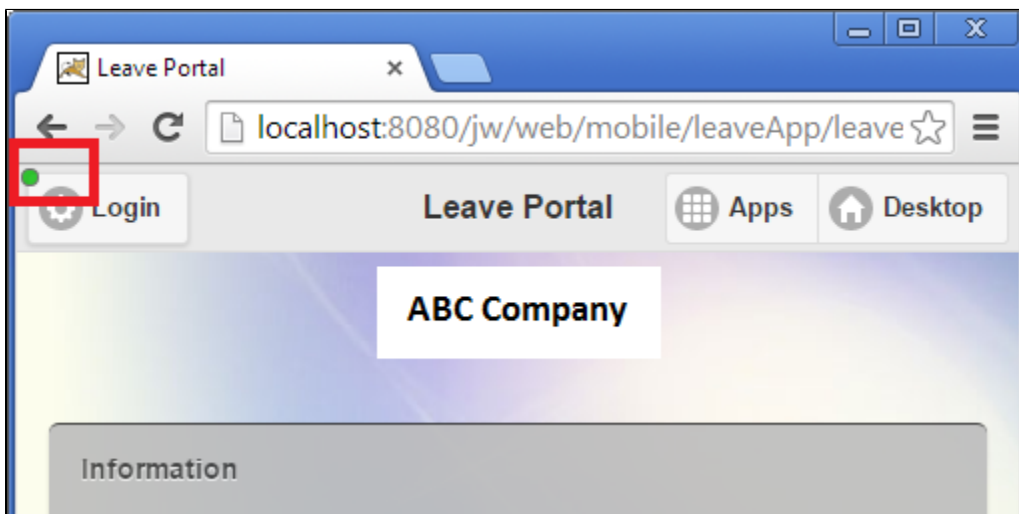


Figure 7: Online status indicator
