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**Prevent XSS Attack**

When using [Hash Variable](#) that uses URL parameter or user-inputted value in your custom JS scripts, ensure that these hash variable(s) are **escaped**.

Make use of hash variable escape keywords, see [Hash Variable - Escaping the Resultant Hash Variable](#).

Use **?javascript** hash variable escape. Example:

#requestParam.id?**javascript**#

## Introduction

You can use **HTML Page** userview element to design the layout and structure of your own custom page using the rich text editor or writing HTML/CSS/JS.

HTML Page is commonly used as the homepage/landing page of an app.

## HTML Page Properties

### Edit HTML Page

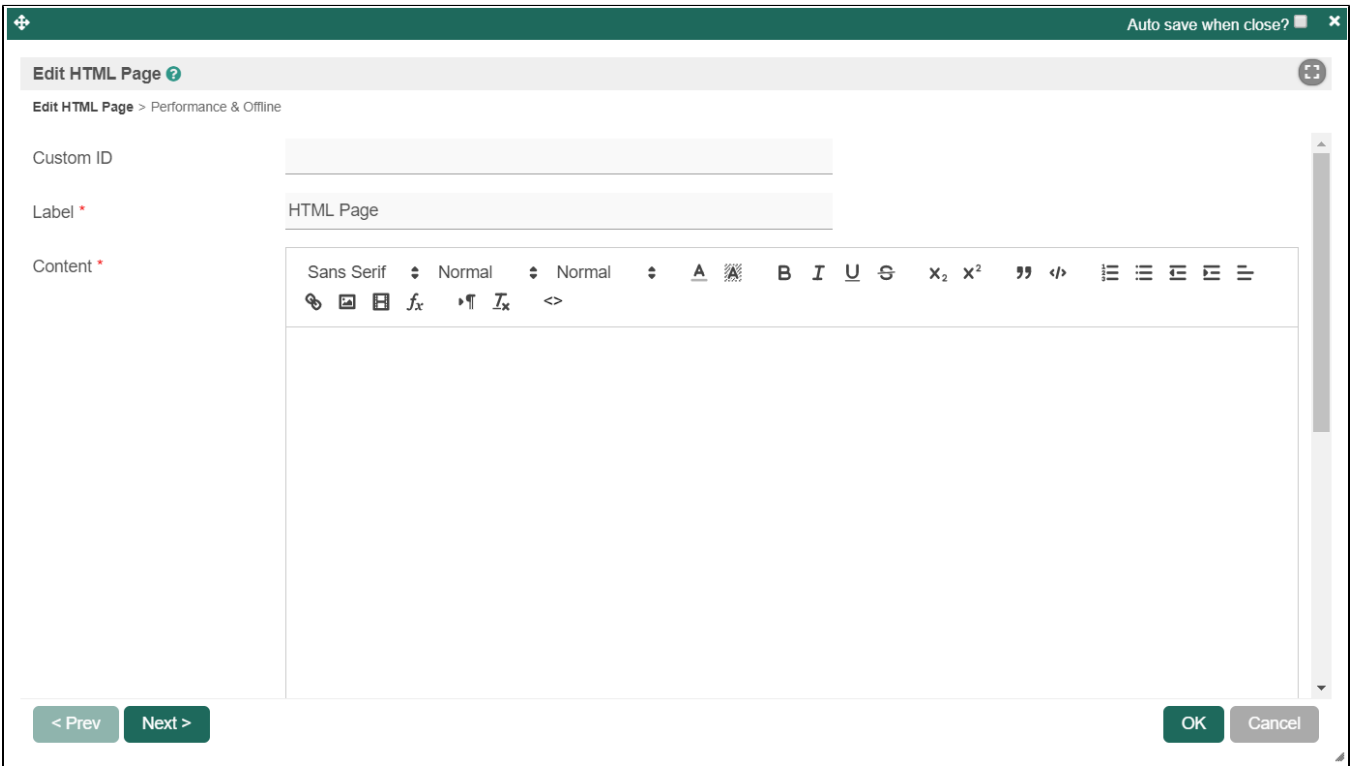







Figure 1: HTML Page Properties


Name	Description
id	Menu element unique id. Userview will use this id in the URL for the menu if the Custom ID is empty.
Custom ID	Item link slug. Optional field. <div>  Ensure that value defined here is <b>unique</b> to other userview menus in the app, since the <b>first matching/conflicting ID</b> will take precedence in page loading. </div>
Label	The HTML Page userview menu label.
Content	Page content.





## Welcome to Expenses Claim App

The Expenses Claim app has been written specially for Joget DX Enterprise/Professional.

This app uses many of the new features and capabilities of Joget DX in forms, datalist and userview.

The Expenses Claim app was designed for employees to submit and head of departments (HOD) to approve expense claims online.

**Workflow Design**

1. The claimant submits a New Expenses Claim.
2. Expense claim is routed to the selected HOD for approval.
3. If approved, the expense claim is routed the Finance Department for verification and processing of payment (This app defaults the finance approver to 'admin, which you can change in the "Map Participants to Users" screen).
4. HOD can request the claimant to resubmit the expense claim and the expense claim will redirect back to the claimant's inbox for reevaluation, or the HOD can reject it which ends the process flow.

**Before using this app, perform the following steps: (Need admin role permission)**

1. Set up the [Claim Categories](#) (Example: Entertainment, Medical, Mileage and Toll etc.).
2. Input your Joget DX SMTP server configurations in [Web Console > General Settings](#) to send email messages.
3. Input an email address for admin user in [Web Console > Setup Users](#) for email notification to work.

### Cache Settings

Name	Description
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Scope	Caching options are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>None:</b> No caching.</li><li>• <b>Application:</b> Cache content by application where all users will see the same content.</li><li>• <b>User:</b> Cache by username</li></ul>
Duration (s)	Duration in seconds to cache content, defaults to 20 seconds if applicable.
